

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How long will the Centre be closed for?

To undertake the works the centre will be required to be temporarily closed and current estimates are that the closure is likely to be 6 months.

The full centre closure will commence from Saturday 11 January 2025. The gym will be closed as of Friday 10 January 2025 to relocate gym equipment.

Why are you closing the entire Centre?

Mornington Peninsula Shire are completing necessary upgrades to existing equipment that has reached end of life and undertake various other works across the facility. There will be impact upon the aquatic and gym experience and the closure is necessary to protect the safety of staff, members and visitors.

Will my membership fees be reduced?

Can I suspend my membership free of charge?

Health Club & Aquatic Members

Yes. Communication will be sent to all Aquatic and Health Club members to opt into suspending at no charge for the following periods.

- Premier Members - Full closure period from 10 January 2025
- Premier & Aquatic Members - Full Closure period from 11 January 2025

Any suspensions outside the above durations, will be processed as per normal terms and conditions.

GOswim

Please refer to current communication regarding summer swimming options. 2025 programming will commence following this period from Monday 20 January 2025.

Should you wish to suspend for the duration of the closure, you will be able to opt into suspending from Monday 20 January 2025, when the program commences for 2025.

Adequate warning will be provided to recommence payments prior to the reopening.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Will I still have my regular GOswim lesson when the Centre reopens?

We anticipate that classes will resume as normal, existing members will have priority to resume classes.

Will GOswim lessons continue during the closure?

Our 2025 GOswim program will resume across both Crib Point Pool and Yawa Aquatic Centre Rosebud from Monday 20 January 2025. Where possible, lesson days and times will match those transitioning from Pelican Park.

To assist the team in scheduling classes, please advise a member of our team your preferred location at your earliest convenience prior to lessons re-commencing Monday 20 January 2025.

Will Aqua Classes continue during the closure?

Yes. Aqua Classes will continue at Crib Point Pool with some additional low impact land based classes specifically for our Aqua community held at our studio pop up, Hastings Community Hub.

Will Crib Point be open longer for swimming?
